I need clothes: Open clothing bank on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays 10am-11:45am and 12:30pm-2:45pm.

I want to donate clothes: Donations can be dropped off 7 days a week from 8am-6:30pm. Hope Haven prefers that donors call beforehand.

An Angel's Wing Thrift Store:

I need clothes: Open 7 days a week, 9am-5pm. Case managers can fill out a form for the client, then clothing will be received. Those who are homeless without case managers are able to walk-in and pick out a few items they need.

I want to donate clothes: Open 7 days a week, Mondays through Sundays 9am-5pm. Call ahead before bringing your new and gently used donations to ensure there is room.
